### **IV. Old Business**

#### **1. Review Barrel Festival profit/loss.**

There are 40 vendors already signed up for 2014. Mayor Childs advised they actually did a little better than break even...they made \$50. He also suggested a sale price for event t-shirts at next year's event, buy one and get last year's shirt at half price.

#### **2. Confirm 2014 Barrel Festival date.**

Chairman Buck asked for a motion to confirm Saturday, June 7, 2014 as the date for next year's event.

Discussion included the Remember the Removal Riders and the date they will possibly pass through Coopertown.

3. Confirm times: 10 am – 4 pm, with a potential evening concert hosted by Compassion International (Todd Stewart) providing national acts.  
Chairman Buck asked for a motion to keep the festival hours from 10 am – 4 pm with the potential of an evening concert.

Mayor Childs made the motion for festival hours to begin at 10 am and end at 4 pm with a potential evening concert.  
Linda Lee seconded the motion.

4. Vote on increase in booth fees for 2014.  
Chairman Buck asked for a motion to increase the booth fees from \$20 to \$40.

Linda Lee made the motion to increase booth fees to \$40.  
Jimi Chappell seconded the motion.

All in favor signified by saying "Aye."  
The motion passed unanimously.

5. Vote on increase in sponsorship fees (2013 Platinum \$500, Gold \$300, Silver \$50, Bronze donation).  
Chairman Buck asked for a motion to increase sponsorship fees for 2014 to: Platinum \$600, Gold \$400, Silver \$200, Bronze \$100.

Betty Winters made the motion to increase sponsorship fees as discussed.  
Linda Lee seconded the motion.

All in favor signified by saying "Aye."  
The motion passed unanimously.

## **V. New Business**

1. Frierson Chapel restoration project.  
Chairman Buck mentioned the restoration project and asked the CDC to help with the Mum Sale for Fundraising. She also mentioned supporting a Basket Rally Day Picnic on August 18th.

Other community events to support include weekly Exercise Classes at Chappell Acres and a viewing of the Church Model built by Bill Wilson.
